

## Important notes

**Registration:** All participants must pre-register, either online, by mail or at the Special Olympics Fun Run booth #305 at the PIANJ conference trade show. Runners' bibs must be picked up before the race.

**Entry fee:** A minimum of \$80 is required for each pre-registered participant. There will be a prize for the top three fundraisers, so get out there and raise some money!

**Teams:** All team photos will be taken near the start line, before the race, between 6:30 and 6:55 a.m. Please report to the registration desk to pick up your team banner when you are ready for your team photo. If your team photo is not taken prior to the race, please see a PIA staff member at the breakfast following the Fun Run.

**Awards breakfast:** A complimentary breakfast in the Tiara Ballroom at Trump Taj Mahal immediately following the race is available to all participants. Race winners and sponsors will be recognized and fundraising awards will be presented at that time. Please check with staff at the door—there will be reserved seating for all runners.

**Door prizes:** Each participant will receive one door prize ticket upon registration. Additional tickets will be on sale throughout the trade show at the Fun Run booth for \$5 each. Door prizes will be drawn at the breakfast. You need not be present to win.
